

**Moving Timeline** 

- Determine moving method & interview movers
- Begin weeding through storage spaces and determine what to keep, donate and throw/recycle
- Set aside belongings for a Yard/Garage Sale
- Organize possessions and take inventory

- Select mover and confirm dates
- Start packing items that are used infrequently
- Contact utilities, service providers, banks, credit card companies, brokerage firms with new address
- Magazine subscription change of address

- Clearly mark each box as your pack with the contents and room where it should be placed
- Confirm moving date with moving company

- Clean out the refrigerator
- Pack a suitcase for each person with enough clothes for a couple of days
- Prepare a special box marked "Move Day." In it, have the following: a telephone, light bulbs, tool kit, scissors, flashlight, large trash bags, paper towels, toilet paper, aspirin and fresh bed linens.
